- _____ 1. Students are admitted for the full academic year and / or summer session. ***The obligation to pay the agreed tuition is not subject to adjustment for illness, absence or any other reason.*** If it becomes necessary to withdraw your child, written notice is kindly requested **THIRTY DAYS PRIOR TO WITHDRAWAL. Tuition is charged through the last 30 days of attendance.**
- _____ 2. **Monthly tuition is payable on the first of the month** (regardless of start date and day of the week) **\$1,037.00 Full Time / \$645.00 Part Time. Kindergarten \$1,002.00 (must be 5 years old as of October 1, 2020).**
- _____ 3. Late tuition will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee after the third of the month. There will be an additional \$2.00 per day after. Overlooked additional fees will result in a letter from our office. Insufficient funded checks will have a \$25.00 fee.
- _____ 4. Hours for extended care are from 6:30 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. Guardians who arrive after 6:30 p.m. (Full Time), or 12:00 p.m. (Part Time), will be charged \$5.00 per 5 minutes late. Pay adult in charge at the time of pickup.
- _____ 5. If the undersigned has medical insurance, that policy will be considered primary for medical expenses incurred for accidental injury or illness.
- _____ 6. During a one-week period twice each year, you are required to provide the classroom snack. The Directress will explain this program to you.
- _____ 7. Chronic misbehavior results in unhappy children and a disruptive learning environment. When a child becomes disruptive, the guardian will be notified. If the behavior continues, guardians may be asked to seek professional guidance. Our responsibility to your child includes the obligation to limit this disruption from the learning experience. If a child cannot modify his/her behavior, you will be asked to remove your child from the school.
- _____ 8. If your child has a medical condition, please inform the director and provide appropriate medical documentation and paperwork. The decision for acceptance to the school is on an individual basis with collaboration of the director, school's nurse, parents, your medical provider, and staff.

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- _____ 9. If your child has a health condition and you choose to not share that information with the school, or you choose not to provide daily or emergency medication and applicable permission forms if needed or prescribed, the undersigned parent(s) or legal guardian(s) agree to release the school and its personnel from any and all claim(s), which they now have or may hereafter have arising regarding the consequences of this choice, and are aware that 911 may be called in an emergency. Please note, Montessori School of Aurora reserves the right to discontinue care for child(s) falsified or neglected medical information provided or not provided.
- _____ 10. Montessori School of Aurora does **not** give credit for lost time for any reason (illness, vacations, etc).
